1922 Compact.

minimum objective annual release of 8.23 MAF  
not part of 68 Act

Bank storage  
releases above 8.23 MAF  
• maintain equal storage between Mead and Powell  
• Additional water needed in lower basin  
• to avoid spills

AOP -

surplus declarations

602(a) storage

1995 AOP declared that surplus flows above power plant capacity could be used to make Beach Habitat flows.

Randy spoke about reservoir operations and forecasting  
showed overhead of nine release scenarios

1970 criterion stated that - considerations are  
flood control, river regulation, benefit, consumptive use, power production  
water quality control, recreation, enhancement of fish and wildlife  
other environmental factors

there was some discussion as to the 1992 Act rearranging priorities of the previous acts. Bob Lyach set the record straight that it does not. It does give more attention to the existing laws requirements and establishes a program to address them.
