Enclosed is a draft of a figure in my new book, "A Primer on Rivers," to be published within the next year by Harvard University Press. It is written for people like you.

The data on depths go from Green River, Utah, to Hite, but this diagram is for only the Cataract part. The original data and the photos are in the Bancroft Library of the University of California, Berkeley, and are available to the public for non-commercial use. But use of such manuscript material probably requires that one go to the Library itself.

The depth data were for the week including June 8, 1967, at a discharge of 38900 cfs. I measured the discharge of the Green and added the USGS measurement of the Colorado at Cisco.
