Plaintiffs Move This Court for a Temporary Injunction ordering and directing defendants to suspend operation of their new water release schedule announced by press release July 27, 1973 and direct them to operate the Glen Canyon Dam in such a way that the water releases shall be as follows: The minimum releases of water from the Glen Canyon Dam shall be four thousand five hundred cubic feet per second, the average water releases for Glen Canyon Dam shall be eight thousand five hundred cubic feet per second.

This motion is made on the ground that immediate and

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This motion is made on the ground that immediate and irreparable injury, loss and damage will result to plaintiffs unless defendants are enjoined as aforesaid and will result immediately. The decreased water releases from Glen Canyon

Dam as announced in the press release of July 27, 1973 will result in the cancellation of plaintiffs' river trips from the present time through the end of the month of September. One river trip is scheduled to begin on Thursday, August 2, 1973 and will not occur unless such Injunction is issued.
